Teaching buy-outs for Oxford postholders

Applications are invited for teaching buy-outs from postholders within the Oxford faculties of Philosophy and Theology, as well as researchers in relevant areas of empirical science, who wish to make a substantial contribution to the research goals of the Project “New Insights and Directions for Religious Epistemology”. The Project includes funding for nine teaching buy-outs, of up to one term each. Further information about the Project can be found on its website at <http://www.newinsights.ox.ac.uk/>.

Applications are particularly encouraged from epistemologists and philosophers of religion. The precise level of buy-out will be agreed on a case-by-case basis and where appropriate will be subject to approval from the postholder’s college. Postholders who receive a buy-out will be expected to dedicate an equivalent amount of time to the Project’s activities, and to participate fully in the life of the Project. Priority will be given to applications from postholders who will make use of the time bought out to complete a paper or monograph of relevance to the project’s aims. The Project will be running workshops on six key themes, and applicants who wish to pursue research related to any of the workshop topics are strongly encouraged, where possible, to time their applications accordingly.
